To prevent accidents and cases of work-related ill health and provide adequate control of health and safety risks arising from work activities.	RIA	Relevant risk assessments completed and actions arising out of those assessments implemented. (Risk assessments reviewed every year or earlier if working habits or conditions change.)	
To provide adequate training to ensure employees are competent to do their work.	SLT & Headteacher	Staff given necessary health and safety induction and provided with appropriate training.	
To engage and consult with employees regarding day-to-day health and safety conditions and provide advice and supervision on occupational health.	Headteacher	Staff routinely consulted on health and safety matters as they arise.	
To implement emergency procedures – evacuation in case of fire or another significant incident.	RIA	Escape routes well signed and kept clear at all times. Evacuation plans are tested from time to time and updated as necessary. Fire checks and other necessary fire-related actions carried out by designated Fire Officers.	
To maintain safe and healthy working conditions, provide and maintain equipment and machinery, and ensure safe storage/use of substances.	RIA	Toilets, washing facilities and drinking water provided. System in place for routine inspections and testing of equipment, and for ensuring that action is promptly taken to address any defects. Staff trained in safe handling/use of substances.
